



Announcement of Chumpholphonphisai School

Subject: No Gift Policy

According to the Cabinet Resolution on December 8, 2020, the national reformation program in terms of prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct has been approved (Revised Edition). It has been stipulated to carry out an important reformation (Big Rock), such as the reformation activity 4, to develop Thai bureaucracy and to be transparent and without benefit. As the first goal (1.1), it is referred as to “All government entities shall declare themselves that all government officials should not accept any kind of gifts in exchange of their due service (No gift policy).

In order to drive the activity according to the aforementioned reformation, to be a transparent entity, to instill values in the performance of duties, and should be treated as a noble custom of the school, Chumpholphonphisai School declares the policy that all executives, government teachers, and educational personnel must not accept directly or indirectly any gift, gratuity, favor, or anything of monetary value from any person in the course of their official duties or on every occasion. If irrevocable, the concerned individual should comply with the rules of accepting gifts and gratuities; following The Notification of the Office of the Prime Minister on Giving or Receiving gifts of Government Officers B.E. 2544 (2001) and Gift Policy and Guidelines to Prevent Bribery and Conflicts of Interest of The Announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission B.E. 2563 (2020).

Announced on July 21, B.E. 2565 (2022).
